




OECS STRATEGIC APPROACH TO SARGASSUM MANAGEMENT



Coordinate research and pool procurement of equipment to assist with the clean-up



Support the exploration of options and present of a business case for use and commercialization



Support or Create a Caribbean Sargassum monitoring network with academic, governmental and NGO representatives



Continue to support Member States in the development and implementation of measures to manage influxes of Sargassum

















OECS STRATEGIC APPROACH TO SARGASSUM MANAGEMENT – CON'T



Articulate a common position on the best available science, and identify the gaps to be filled, including an understanding of the source of the influx



Examine the potential for using Sargassum as a source of biofuels for energy security on small and large scales



Disseminate and share knowledge and proven best practices from Martinique and the wider region



Develop and implement a Communications Strategy, including guidelines for the long term community management of Sargassum
